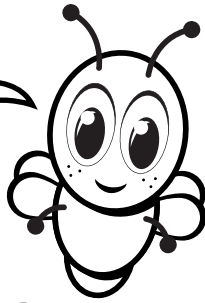


Blinky's Family Challenge

Jesus Cleans The Sin Out!

A pure, clean heart is like fresh water. God can live in a heart like that! But sin makes your heart icky and sticky. Ask Jesus to take the icky, sticky sins right out of your heart!

You'll Need

- Two clear cups full of water
- Something to make the water look dirty

Directions

1. Say, "Let's pretend these cups are hearts!"
2. Put something dirty into one of the cups and mix it all up.
3. **Ask:** Uh-oh. One of these cups has icky, sticky, sin in it. Which one is it? *The dirty one*
4. **Ask:** Can God live in a heart that has icky, sticky sin in it? *No!*
5. **Ask:** What does that heart need to do to get pure and clean again? *Pray for Jesus to take away the sins.*
6. Pray, "Jesus, please forgive my sins. Make a pure, clean heart in me."
7. Pour out the dirty water and fill it with clean water again.
8. Celebrate the pure heart.

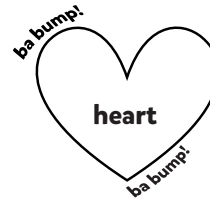
Question:
